

Dr. Otmar Höll has been in charge of the Austrian Institute for International Affairs – oiiip as a director since 1996. He is Visiting Professor at the Danube University of Krems, Austria and has been lecturing at the University of Vienna since 1983. He worked as Professor at the Geschwister-Scholl-Institut for International Relations at the Ludwig-Maximilian University in Munich, as Guest-Professor at the Institutes for Political Science at the Universities of Vienna, Linz, Innsbruck and Tampere.

Dr. Marcus Bergmann was appointed Director for Scientific and Technical Co-operation at the Ministry of European and International Affairs in August 2011. Prior to that, he served as chief negotiator for bilateral investment treaties. He was posted to Washington, D.C. (1999 – 2006) and Geneva (1996). Bergmann is a graduate of the Universities of Linz (Mag. iur. 1989, Dr. iur. 1994) and Georgetown (LL.M., 1994).
